Comments on capacity	There is spare capacity at this school for rugby and football and not clear
	why this is not happening this year
Key Findings and Issues	 Site was managed by Stroud DC but now managed by school who have subcontracted management of Indoor facilities and outdoor courts to Stonehouse Sport. However, SS have not taken on the pitches. Spoke to manager of Stonehouse Sport who said there has been no demand expressed to date for use of pitches (in any event). https://www.stonehousesport.com When site was managed by the District Council, Stroud RFC used the pitches for junior rugby but did not have access to toilet/changing facilities. Therefore could be used for training but not for matches. Need to establish potential and willingness for school to develop/continue community use of football and rugby pitches

	 Thursday night netball, but the majority of netball is indoors. Small group use for 5v5 u11s – Tuesday night training
	SS are trying to encourage weekend use of outdoor courts but no takers at the moment.
	In general uptake for new facilities has been disappointing despite best efforts of SS in doing leaflet drops, posters etc. There was a good start initially but now use has flatlined. Friday and Saturdays – little interest but Monday – Thursday night quite good attendance in sports hall (archery, football, netball). But everyone wants the same slots – Wednesday nights, 6-8pm!! Trying various activities in the sports hall. Ever walking football.
	 Trying various activities in the sports hall – 5v5, walking football, hockey and netball. Hoping use will pick up as Spring approaches.
