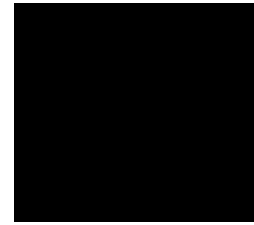

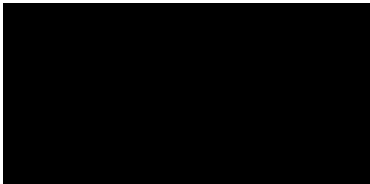
Re: Future house building in Painswick
