

The Issues and Options Paper was primarily aimed at identifying any future potential sites on the edge of settlements that are currently within the countryside and/or not currently acceptable locations for (housing) development. As you know, the New Lawns site is within the existing settlement and therefore, subject to complying with open space policy requirements, could be suitable for redevelopment for housing under the current Local Plan. If the Local Plan Review determines that the appropriate strategy for Nailsworth is to support redevelopment of existing land rather than to support new urban extensions, then we will need to explore whether the New Lawns site should be allocated within the Plan (subject to suitable replacement open space proposals).
