Key Findings and Issues - rugby	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The RFU regard the rugby club as one of the model clubs in Gloucestershire. The club run a full range of adult and midi/mini teams. 2. They are keen to develop girls' rugby, planning for u13, u15 & u18 girls in the next 3 years to feed the women's team. 3. There is no spare capacity on the adult pitches on Saturday afternoon; there is a little spare capacity on the mini/midi pitches at peak time. 4. The senior men's teams train at Rednock School Oct – Feb and would like AGP facility for training. 5. Site identified as potential SHW sports hub as partnership between Dursley Running Club, Dursley RFC and Stinchcombe Stragglers CC (also involves adjacent farmland) to include artificial training area. 6. The capacity of this site would be increased by better floodlights on the training area and also floodlighting of Pitch 2 (Pitch 1 is floodlit, although lights are 10 years old)
