Replacing a toilet seat

Replacing a toilet seat is really simple. Just follow our step by step instructions below:

You will need:

- New toilet seat
- Screwdriver
- Something to protect your knees
- Cloth
- Disinfectant
- Gloves
- Tape measure
- Safety glasses

Removing the current seat

- Step 1: Measure your toilet seat in both width and length, so that you know what size seat you need.
- **Step 2:** If your toilet back straight onto a wall, it may have hidden fixings. Take the seat off the hinges and remove the cover plates and brackets.
- **Step 3:** Once you've removed the seat, give it a clean with some disinfectant. Dry the seat thoroughly to stop any mould growth.

Fixing the new seat

- **Step 1:** Read the manufacturer's instructions first.
- **Step 2:** Drop the nuts through the holes in the toilet and use the screwdriver to tighten them in place.
- Step 3: Push the stainless steel covers over the brackets.
- **Step 4:** Slot the seat into place.
