I would like to object to the proposed development of houses across the Mley Valley from Shakespeare Road.

We have not felt the full impact of the traffic from Littlecomb 400 house estate. The traffic at the Woodmanets end of town is already greatly increased.

The Stinchcomb Hill Golf Course Lane is used by many as a rat run for traffic if there are any hold-ups in the centre of Duxley. This is a single track road with small passing areas and not suitable for heavy traffic. There is a play area + sculpture trail at Twinkarrow woods. No off road parking + no road signs to indicate children crossing. Also there is the

Breakheart Community Project Ltd.  
which attracts considerable traffic with the  
numerous events. No road warning signs  
& off road parking at limited times only.

There is much traffic to the Golf  
club + Achen Plains Camp Site.

Hope these issues are addressed  
befor more development this end of  
town,
