I have been looking at the proposed plans for a new development in Wisloe.

My main concern is the effect of extra traffic on the area . The A38 ands A4135 are currently very busy during peak hours , traffic has got noticeably heavier over the last few years . Since the demise of industry in Dursley most people now travel to work in either the north or the south of the region . there are currently an awful lot of new homes being built in Cam which will impact on the already busy peak travel times . The proposed new village has the potential of making access in and out of Cam/Dursley an almost impossible task . One report I read even suggested putting traffic lights on the railway bridge on the A4135

I have lived in Cambridge for over 30 years . The traffic noise from the nearby M5 has increased . and is now noticeable from the west side of the A38 . Noise levels in parts of the area proposed for building is almost deafening ..

I am also aware (and have been for most of my life) that while this area is currently classified as a low flood risk, with rising sea levels the possibility is that as early as 2050 this could be a very different story

I urge you to please look at building these houses somewhere else . I was particularly interested in the idea of the idea of building these houses in smaller groups throughout the county . To me this makes more sense as it would have less impact on traffic and would give the new residents an easier way to integrate into local communities .
