

NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

In accordance with the requirements of Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by Section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013), notice is hereby given that Stroud District Council shall undertake a review of specific UK Parliamentary polling districts and polling places within the Stroud District.

This review will require submissions to be made by the Acting Returning Officer for the Stroud, North Cotswold and South Cotswold Constituencies. These submissions will be published and made available for inspection at Stroud District Council, Ebley Mill, Ebley Wharf, Stroud, GL5 4UB and at [Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2023 | Stroud District Council](#)

The consultation period for this review will commence on **Tuesday 17 October 2023** and end on **Wednesday 22 November 2023**. Any representations received will be available for public inspection.

We would like to invite all interested parties to make representations and comments on both the existing and proposed polling districts and polling places. In particular, we would welcome any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment on the proposals and Acting Returning Officer's representations.

When making representation, any person or body should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places. Please note that this review does not cover District Ward or Parish boundaries.
