

We note and welcome the suite of mitigation measures described as part of the requirements for the development at paragraph 3.5.22 of the Reg 19 local plan. We therefore regard the Reg19 plan and its HRA as sound and legally compliant in respect of the strategic development proposal.

'For the two Sharpness allocations PS34 and PS36, mitigation measures have been incorporated into the Plan and these will be secured at project level. These measures ensure localised impacts resulting from large amounts of new housing in a single location are addressed. Alongside contributions towards the updated Severn Estuary strategic mitigation scheme these measures will be sufficient to address risks relating to recreation impacts and the Severn Estuary SAC/SPA/Ramsar and ensure adverse effects alone or in-combination are Addressed'.
