I am writing to you about my concerns regarding the proposed 5,000 houses joining Old and New Bradord to Shapness / Newtown and then onto Wenswell and Berkeley.

I think the scale of this project is overwhelming and whilst destroying the beautiful countryside we have inland around the villages (Newtown, Shapness, Old Bradord, New Bradord and Wenswell) and our local town of Berkeley it will also destroy these communities.

I appreciate that some houses are needed and some small infill sites such as Cramwell Close, Newtown and the new Coronbury Rise development at Berkeley are less invasive little projects like this would be much better but to suddenly swamp the area with 5,000 houses would be awful.

For starters where are the children going to go to school?

The current primary schools are full and the secondary school is closed. The hospital and police station shut. Shops have shut. The library is run by volunteers. The doctor surgery @ Maybach is struggling. Our bank has shut.

Then also 5,000 houses could bring another 10,000-15,000 cars. The roads at present are diabolical, parking is a major issues - Old lanes are being used as rat runs. The by pass has never been completed and the MS junction at Fulfield is at breaking point now. There is just no infrastructure here for this.

People will come to the area and just commute out everyday. They won't become a part of the community. All our local history and community will be lost forever.

I just hope this decision will be reviewed. A small amount of houses here and there ~~YES~~ but NOT 5,000
