Strategic policies should in accordance with the NPPF look ahead over a minimum of 15 years from adoption and anticipate and respond to long term requirements and whilst the NPPF and the PPG provide the framework

Pegasus support the policy in so far as the target is for all new development "to be located where the form and mix of development itself or proximity to essential services and facilities minimises the need to travel"... " to deliver the highest possible share of trips by the most sustainable travel modes".

Locations such as PS19a Northwest Stonehouse, PS24 Cam North West and omission site Grove End Farm, Whitminster support this policy.

The new Future Homes Standard was announced in January 2021. The new Future Homes Standard should ensure that all new homes built from 2025 will produce 75-80% less carbon emissions than homes delivered under current regulations.

The Government will first update the Building Regulations later this year to ensure new homes built from 2022 produce 31% less carbon emissions compared to current standards. In 2023 the government will consult about technical aspects of the Future Homes Standard before updating the Regulations again to come into force in 2025.
