

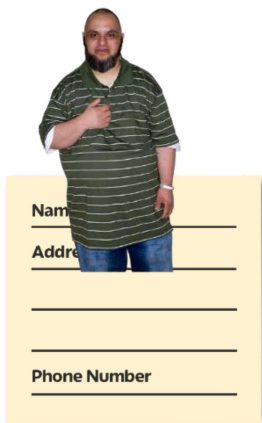
How do I register to vote?



Before you can vote in an election, you must register to vote.



If you have moved to a different address



or changed your name since you registered

you will need to update your details.
