I object to the plan for a new development in Cambridge/ Slimbridge for the following reasons

- 1, the small nature of the existing settlement would mean that it would be swamped by the new one.
2. The proposed land to be built upon is agricultural land that has been classified as grade 2 for more than half a century, this has recently been reclassified presumably to permit development.
3. The main employment areas are too far away, transport infrastructure is already inadequate.
4. There would be a massive increase in surface water run off, as can be seen by the amount of standing water in the fields as a result of the recent heavy rain, a very high proportion of that water would be captured by buildings ,roads and pavements and would have to be taken somewhere, the Coaley sewerage works is already beyond its design capacity as demonstrated by the number of discharges of untreated effluent.
