Question 3.1 How should we meet future development needs?

Leonard Stanley Parish Council supports the current strategic strategy (Option 1).

Question 3.4

Leonard Stanley should be now classed as a Tier 4, as it has already exceeded the reasonable amount of growth for a Tier 3.

Leonard Stanley already has planning permissions which results in considerable growth of this village, disproportionate to the residents needs or wishes. Leonard Stanley has very limited facilities and a limited bus service, its nearest shop (suitable for a basket shop only) is in the neighbouring village of Kings Stanley. Transport is needed to access shops, secondary schools and health services. The roads appear to be at full capacity and residents have had to put up with numerous road closures and disruption as a result of the ongoing development of Mankley Field.

Question 3.5a / b and 3.6 Settlement Boundaries

Leonard Stanley Parish Council strongly objects to the expansion of its settlement boundary. They do not wish to see any further encroachment of the countyside and rejects the proposals put forward for the development of land identified as LEO01 (LEO A) and LEO04 (LEO B).
