Dear Stroud District Council,

As a resident of Slimbridge, I am writing to object to the proposal in the Emerging Strategy Paper to build the new 'Wisloe Green' settlement near Cambridge:

- The plan to build 1500 new homes near Cam and Dursley seems very disproportionate.
- Wisloe Green uses farming land, not brownfield sites
- The current amenities, infrastructure and transport systems are already stretched – flooding in recent years has highlighted the limitations of the sewage system – the system has been paired but would not be sufficient to support such a disproportionate increase in use.
- The land forms an important part of the natural drainage system – it is often very wet. Flooding has been an issue in this area – covering such a large area with manmade materials has the potential to cause serious problems.
- A development of this size would vastly impact and change the character of the surrounding area and villages.

I do hope you will take these points into account.
