We wish to object to the proposal to build 1500 houses in the development referred to as Wisloe Green.

- 1 This development will lead to the coalescence of Slimbridge, Cambridge and Gossington with Cam and Dursley. These five communities each have a distinct and different character that will be lost.
- 2 Too many houses are proposed for the south of the district, when taking into account the proposed developments at Sharpness and another 900 houses in Cam plus others in Dursley. A larger share must be taken by the north of the Stroud district. Why not build closer to junction 13 of the M5 where there are already good transport links?
- 3 Developers cannot be relied upon to provide all the necessary infrastructure to support the number of houses to be built: schools, shops, doctors surgeries, improved roads and junctions, sewage disposal, etc.
- 4 Some of the land in the proposal is grade 2 arable land that should not be built on.
