<b>Project name and location: 'Art Shelter' - Bus Shelter Art Project</b>	
<p><b>Brief description of works undertaken:</b>            Studio 18 was commissioned by Brimscombe and Thrupp Parish Council to revamp the bus shelters on the A419 London Road into inspiring and engaging art installations. Ten bus stops were transformed into public works of art forming a trail along London Road, feeding creatively into the Brimscombe and Thrupp community. The project also included a launch event in September 2020.</p> <p><b>Date Project Completed: September 2020</b></p> <p><b>Has the project been successful? How?</b>            Yes. All 10 of the bus stops were revamped and have been well received not only by the community, but by other Parish Council's who have been inspired by the project. The launch event was well attended, and the whole project provided some joy within the community at such a challenging time.</p>
