Compensation is then calculated using the following formula:

Cost of work X 1 minus years elapsed since completion

Notional life of improvement

If replacement windows were put in ten years ago costing £2000, this is calculated as follows:

Number of complete years (10) divided by the notional life (20) = 0.5

Then $1 - 0.5 = 0.5 \times 2000$ (original cost) = £1000 (compensation payable)
