Subject: Painswick proposed settlement boundary extensions

Dear Sir, I would like to make the following objections to the proposed settlement boundary extensions notably A and B.

Area A is covering a large area of outstanding natural beauty stretching down the hillside to the west of the A46 into the Painswick valley and up the other side of the escarpment towards the wooded ridge around Sheepscombe . This is a natural dividing space between the end of Painswick settlement and the hamlets of The Park and Damsels green and the Washwell Farm land area, which area A comprises, should not be encroached on by what will be a massive housing development obliterating the countryside aspect of that part of the Painswick valley and remote from the community in central Painswick . This will be another unnecessary strip development along the A46 which should not be allowed for its sheer size and potential density which will inevitably result from the greed of developers intent on constructing as many houses as possible in any area , regardless of the appropriateness on the surrounding countryside and the local town.

The size of the likely developments and the density of housing which may be built on site B is equally inappropriate to a village/town like Painswick where the spaciousness and perspective of the surrounding countryside should not be deleteriously affected by mass housing developments which will occur if this plan is accepted.
