Re - S.D.C's ^{DEVELOPMENT} work to prepare for local plan of Painswick, with a proposal to build on land to the North of Painswick, known as Washwell Fields.

I wish to object to this proposal on the grounds that -

1, It is not in keeping with any of the old houses in and around Painswick, mostly listed, and would ruin the approach to one of the best known old towns in this part of the Cotswolds.

2 This is farmland and should not be used to build houses on.

3 The access, which is apparently to be into Lower Washwell Lane, is completely inappropriate. It is very narrow, with children walking up and down at school times, to catch school buses and cars arriving, and turning to collect

them. The bend just off the main Road,
into the lane, is also quite dangerous,
and with many extra cars, would make
it only worse.

4 The access onto the main road is
also quite blocked already at rush
hour, with cars coming in from the
Gloucester road as well.

I hope you will consider these
points carefully, before making your
decision.
