<b>Pitches on this site – cricket quality</b>	Disused cricket ground; cricket no longer played here. 1 adult pitch rated standard, sideways slope. Enough flat grass for a junior pitch. Club Rate ground as acceptable, as on a slope. Public field and dog fouling can be an issue. Parking can be difficult as narrow land but no other major issues.			
<b>Other sports facilities</b>	2 acrylic courts, rated good. Not floodlit. Locked; access is via Painswick LTC. One 6 rink green on land adjacent, with pavilion (Lottery funded). Lovely green fencing, good grass surface.

<b>Key Findings and Issues</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Disused cricket ground for some years</li> <li>2. Village recreation ground with tennis courts, outdoor gym, play area etc. .</li> <li>3. 1 adult football pitch rated standard; on a sideways slope but there is enough flat grass for a junior pitch. However when Painswick FC had a youth team, it played at Bisley (team disbanded last year, mainly due to lack of a coach)</li> <li>4. Just one adult team playing here at the moment, but well supported.</li> <li>5. Identified as key site as bowls green and clubhouse potentially may be lost under plans to provide car parking.</li> </ol>
