

THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

WHEREAS the Stroud District Council is satisfied that traffic on the streets set out in the Schedule hereto should be prohibited between the hours and dates set out on the schedule below for the purposes of holding Nailsworth Goodwill during which event the bus station/Old Market car park (including the exit from the one-way street to the rear of 1 to 12 Old Market (parade of shops) and the two parking spaces next to this exit), and Market Street is liable to be obstructed.

AND WHEREAS the said Stroud District Council is empowered by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, as amended, to make an Order prohibiting the use of that area and Street by all classes of vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, as amended, the Stroud District Council **DOES HEREBY ORDER** that all classes of vehicles in the area and street listed in the Schedule hereto other than those vehicles employed by any emergency service shall be prohibited.
