
The Stroud District Council (Eastington Footpath 13) Stopping Up Order 2020

THIS ORDER IS MADE by Stroud District Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to stop up the footpath to which this Order relates to enable the development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely the erection of a new Primary School and Nursery at the site known as Parcel PS1 Land West Of Stonehouse, Grove Lane, Westend [Planning Permission Reference S/14/0810/OUT and S.19/1122/REM].

BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown by a solid black line between points A and B on the attached plan and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up as provided below.
- 2. The stopping up of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Stroud District Council confirm this Order.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which this Order comes into effect there is apparatus in, on, over, under, along or across the Original Section belonging to statutory undertakers for carrying on their undertaking, those undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of that apparatus as they then had.

This Order may be cited as the "Stroud District Council (Eastington Footpath 13) Stopping Up Order 2020".
