Refurbishment of park including paths, new entrance, zip wire, swings, benches, stone amphitheatre and trees.

**Date Project Completed:**

November 2019

**Has the project been successful? How?**

The project has increased access for residents into a public park on the edge of a large area of housing. Paths, seating and picnic tables make the park friendly for people of all ages and mobility. It has increased health and well-being by encouraging free access to outdoor gym equipment, views of the countryside (helping to improve mental health) and providing opportunities for active and imaginative play (the zip wire, swings and amphitheatre).
