We respond only in respect of the proposal for extension of the village plan for Oakridge Lynch, to provide for housing in the area marked OAK.A.  We are wholly in favour of this proposal, SO LONG as the development on that area includes substantial provision for hopefully social housing, or at worst private development on small units priced so that young people could afford to buy. In addition any development should include small bungalows suitable for older people which should be subject to a restriction thatthey cannot be converted to houses. Only by keeping a mix of population will the village amenities: school, shop/post office, pub be viable. At the moment there is no reasonably priced housing in the village, which we consider vital to a mix of population, and in particular for young people who have grown up in the village but are not in highly paid jobs to remain here. Our strong preference is for social housing, to provide the diversity the community is currently lacking.
