	1. 2 adult football pitches and 2 9v9 pitches catering for 11 junior and 5 mini teams. Pitches are efficiently used and are catering to the level they can sustain, just, but there is little room for club expansion between here and the Synwell Playing Field site.					
	2. Discussions ongoing around viability of full size 3G FTP at this site but					
	would require extensive remodelling of community parc area?					
	Hockey:					
	Priority for WUE Hockey Club is new clubhouse/pavilion/changing facilities which can be used by all sports
