Please accept this email as notification of my objection to the proposed development (plan PS37) to build on the land at Wisloe.

I object to the development as it would have adverse environmental effects caused by a high percentage of occupants of the dwellings needing to use a car to travel to work and for other purposes. This will increase the noise levels and pollution on the A38 to exceed permitted levels.

The air quality from increased vehicle emissions on A38 and M5 from this development will have a huge impact on the health and wellbeing of the residents of Slimbridge.

The village junior and infant school is located within 150 yards of A38, Stroud district council should consider the severe impact an additional 6,000 cars, plus more from Berkeley/Sharpness development, will have on the health of the children of Slimbridge.

For the reasons given, the application to build on the land at Wisloe should be refused, and I respectfully ask the Council to do so.
