I wish to express my view that the canal strategy (video and documents):

- completely misunderstands the importance of the unrestored canal basin in terms of its wildlife, heritage and people's access to nature.
- makes little reference to ecology and provides no ecological baseline information.
- uses too much jargon and is difficult to interpret, and therefore doesn't encourage engagement for most people.
- is misleading in not acknowledging any barriers (legal, planning etc) to achieving the intended aim.
- does not mention anything about The Environment Act 2021 and the need for Biodiversity Net Gain. Any
  offsetting biodiversity impacts (which will be significant) needs to be within 250m of the canal basin, rather
  than offset elsewhere along the canal outside of the parish.

I therefore have major misgivings over the strategy and strongly the oppose restoration of the canal east of Brimscombe as this would result in a net loss of biodiversity for the Brimscombe and Chalford area. Thank you
